Our records indicate that your student has not yet attempted the California High School Exit Exam(CAHSEE) with Connecting Waters in Feb 2008. The CAHSEE exams are required for our CWCS students in the tenth grade. Your student is scheduled to test on the following date/s at the location indicated below:

Testing begins promptly at 10am. There are two sections to the test each day with a break in between. The **tests are un-timed** and generally take approximately 2.5 hours to complete each section(**approximately 5** hours total). Both sections must be completed each day.

A photo ID is required in order to test.

Remember to bring snacks and water as students are not allowed to leave the test site once they arrive.
