Our records indicate that your student has not yet passed one or both of the California High School Exit Exams. There is one more opportunity this year to attempt them on the dates below.

Testing begins promptly at 10am. There are two sections to the test each day with a break in between. The **tests are un-timed** and generally take approximately 2.5 hours to complete each section(**approximately 5** hours total). Both sections must be completed each day.

A photo ID is required in order to test.

Remember to bring snacks and water as students are not allowed to leave the test site once they arrive.
