

California History–Social Science Standards Tests

- Students in grade 8 take the grade-level CST for History–Social Science.
- All students in grade 11 take the CST for U.S. History found in the grade-level multiple-choice test booklet. Some of these students will also take the end-of-course CST for World History (see next bullet).
- Students in grades 9, 10, and 11 can take the end-of-course CST for World History only if they have completed a World History course in the 2007 summer session or during the 2007–08 school year.
- The district STAR coordinator, in conjunction with the school’s history–social science department, should determine when the EOC CST for World History should be administered by identifying whether the CST for World History blueprint is closely aligned with the course content. - A student may retake the CST for World History if the student completed the course during the previous school year and took the appropriate test, but is now retaking the course during the 2007–08 school year to improve his or her grade.
