

## ORDERING OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEXTBOOK & A-G TEXTBOOKS

Please know that we use California Edition textbooks, NOT national textbooks. Our A-G textbooks will be California Edition textbooks.

The mainline publishers (Glenco, Holt, Prentice Hall, McDougal Littell, McGraw-Hill, Harcourt, Houghton Mifflin) typically post their national textbooks to their websites, NOT California Editions (although they are getting better at posting the CA Edition information).

Steps to locating California Edition textbook ordering and pricing information:

1. First, look in the ES Secure Website/Vendor Info/subject/grade
2. Email the Curriculum Coordinator, Shelley Ross, [curriculum@ieminc.org](mailto:curriculum@ieminc.org), who is VERY happy to email or direct you to the correct ordering and pricing information.
3. ALMOST NEVER get your public school textbook ordering and pricing information from the textbook vendor's website, because most of the time, you will not get the California Edition ISBN's. Please email Shelley Ross, [curriculum@ieminc.org](mailto:curriculum@ieminc.org) for that information.

Why is it important to NOT use national textbooks? Because we are supposed to be covering the California standards, and the national textbooks usually do not cover our California standards exactly. Also, the newer California Edition textbooks have begun to "front load" the key standards, insuring that those standards are taught before students take their STAR CST's.
